

Be a Clean Air Ambassador!

The <u>Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District</u> is seeking first- or second-year UCSB undergraduate students to help launch our new Clean Air Ambassadors program. This is a **paid**, part-time position to begin in November 2018. Students will gain teaching experience by helping elementary-level students learn about air pollution and ways to help improve air quality.

Projects:

- Assist with the development of a K-3 curriculum related to air pollution and its impacts
- Solicit teacher participation in Santa Barbara County
- Teach the curriculum in K-3 classrooms
- Work at the District outreach booth at community events throughout Santa Barbara County

Requirements:

- Interest in and enthusiasm for teaching and/or environmental education
- Interest and basic understanding of air quality concepts
- Previous work experience with children ages 5-8 (including coaching and camp counselor experience)
- Ability to travel within Santa Barbara County
- Ability to work as part of a team as well as individually

The selected students will ideally remain with the District and the Clean Air Ambassadors program for 1-2 years beyond this current school year. Hours are flexible, and can range from 0-20 hours per week, with an occasional evening or weekend commitment for community events. The District will work to accommodate class schedules, and summer employment is optional. Upon passing a background check, the students will work in our Santa Barbara and/or Santa Maria office as well as travel to schools throughout the county.
