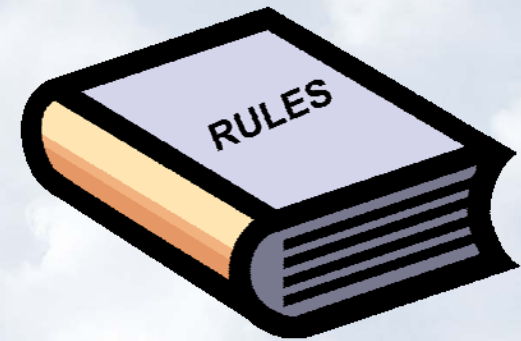

Public Review

- Initial draft rule released: February
- Public workshop: March
- Revised the draft rule: Early April
- Published a comments/responses list: Mid-April
- Community Advisory Council: Mid-May
- Published an updated comments/responses list and updated draft rule: Late May

Recommendations

- The Community Advisory Council and District staff recommend that your Board adopt Rule 323.1
- Hold a Public Hearing
- Approve the Resolution
 - CEQA Findings
 - Rule Findings
 - Rule 323.1
