Dear Kimberley McCarthy:

The Air Pollution Control District (District) has reviewed the applicant's "Response to APCD Incompleteness Items for Louis Armstrong – Cannabis Cultivation, 19DVP-00000-00008" dated September 30, 2019. Several items from our March 15, 2019 letter remain outstanding and require response.

The applicant should provide the information requested below:

1. The applicant has indicated that the proposed project includes non-volatile manufacturing operation and a "back-up generator to be used in emergencies only."
 - a. For the proposed non-volatile cannabis manufacturing, please describe in detail the processes, equipment, and end-product.
 - b. For the proposed emergency generator, please provide a description of the proposed engine and its usage, including the proposed location of the engine, what activities/processes/structures the proposed engine will supply power to, and the engine's specifications including year, make, model, brake horsepower, fuel type, and engine tier.
2. Please provide the expected trip generation as a result of the proposed project, including the expected average daily trips and trip types (e.g. worker commute trips, delivery trips/trucks, etc.)
3. Please provide the proposed project's estimated energy use in kW hour per year.

Once the necessary information is provided, the District can determine applicability of District permit requirements, prohibitory rules, and other regulatory programs such as the State's Distributed Generation Program, and will provide further direction to the County regarding the information required to determine potential air quality impacts from the proposed project.

Once the project has been deemed complete, the District can submit a departmental condition letter for the project. Please ensure that all applicable District conditions are included with the Conditions of Approval for the project.
