RESOLUTION

Whereas, Joni Gray has a distinguished record of dedicated public service including serving on the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors and the Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors for over 14 years; and

Whereas, during Joni Gray's tenure on the APCD Board, Santa Barbara experienced dramatic improvements in air quality, improving from a status of "severe nonattainment" of the federal ozone health standard to full compliance with all federal air quality health standards; and

Whereas, during Joni Gray's tenure on the APCD Board, she participated in the adoption of the Clean Air Plans of 1998, 2001, 2004, 2007 and 2010 to protect and improve the air quality of Santa Barbara County; and

Whereas, Joni Gray diligently advocated for the residents of Orcutt in their efforts to ensure that dust generating agricultural operations were appropriately controlled; and

Whereas, Joni Gray has consistently supported the APCD's successful efforts to compel the federal Environmental Protection Agency to promulgate regulations to control the air pollution emitted by ocean-going vessels that traverse the Santa Barbara channel;


