The Petitioner is requesting continued relief from the requirements associated with operating an H2S analyzer to continuously measure H2S concentrations in the gas, as specified in District Rules 328, 206, and Part 70/Permit to Operate 8092-R9 Conditions 9.C.7(a)(i), 9.C.12 and 9.C.12(a). The Petitioner is requesting continued relief from the requirements to perform source testing on multiple pieces of permitted equipment, as specified in District Rules 328, 342, 206, and Part 70/Permit to Operate 8092-R9 Conditions 9.C.1(c)(iii), 9.C.5(b)(v), 9.C.7(c)(ii), 9.C.12, 9.C.12(b) and 9.C.18(a). The Petitioner operates the equipment described in the Petition at the POPCO gas processing plant, approximately 25 miles northwest of the City of Santa Barbara, California.
