**INTRODUCTION**

1. On January 12, 2021, Petitioner Aeron Arlin Genet, Air Pollution Control Officer (“CONTROL OFFICER”) of the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District (“DISTRICT”), filed with this Hearing Board a Petition for Order of Revocation regarding California Asphalt Production, Inc.’s (“RESPONDENT”) Permit to Operate 8259-R11, Permit to Operate 11651-R4, Permit to Operate 15241, Permit to Operate 15361, and Authority to Construct 15342.
2. According to the California Secretary of State’s records, California Asphalt Production, Inc. is an active California Corporation (CA Corporate Number: C1844044). According to the California Secretary of State’s records, the officers of the corporation are Randeep S. Grewal (CEO) and M. Ernesto Olivares (Secretary and CFO). The agent for Service of Process of California Asphalt Production, Inc. is Capitol Corporate Services, Inc. (Lo Saechao, 455 Capitol Mall Complex, Suite 217, Sacramento, CA 95814).
3. HVI Cat Canyon, Inc., an entity associated with RESPONDENT, filed for bankruptcy on July 25, 2019. As of the date of this Order, the DISTRICT and Hearing Board are not aware of any bankruptcy petitions filed by RESPONDENT.

1 4. The Petition for Revocation was heard by the District Hearing Board on February 3, 2021  
2 pursuant to noticing in accordance with the provisions of Health and Safety Code sections  
3 40823 and 40827.

4 5. This matter having been fully presented and duly considered, the Hearing Board makes the  
5 following findings and determinations and issues the following Order of Revocation pursuant  
6 to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

7 **FINDINGS**

8 6. The Hearing Board finds that RESPONDENT has failed to pay properly assessed fees and  
9 penalties pursuant to state law and District rules is thus operating in violation of District  
10 Rule 210.V(A)(1) and (2) related to Permit to Operate 8259-R11, Permit to Operate 11651-R4,  
11 Permit to Operate 15241, Permit to Operate 15361, and Authority to Construct 15342.

12 7. The Hearing Board finds that the evidence establishing the violation is detailed in Paragraphs  
13 18 through 59 of the "PETITION FOR REVOCATION" filed by the CONTROL OFFICER  
14 on January 12, 2021 and incorporated by reference.

15 8. The Hearing Board finds that based on the above evidence of violations, an Order of  
16 Revocation may properly be ordered.

17 **ORDER**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, the DISTRICT HEARING BOARD ORDERS:**

19 a. RESPONDENT's Permit to Operate 8259-R11, Permit to Operate 11651-R4,  
20 Permit to Operate 15241, Permit to Operate 15361, and Authority to Construct  
21 15342 are hereby revoked.

22 b. This Order shall become effective February 3, 2021 at midnight, unless full  
23 payment of \$21,135.80 as detailed in the Petition for Revocation is received by the  
24 DISTRICT before that time. This Order shall remain in full force and effect until  
25 and unless modified or rescinded by further order of this Hearing Board.

26 c. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as authorizing RESPONDENT to violate  
27 the Health and Safety Code, District Rules, or any other applicable rule or law.  
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- d. This Order shall bind RESPONDENT, its officers, agents and employees. The Order shall also bind RESPONDENT’s heirs, successors, and assigns who acquire ownership or control of the facilities. RESPONDENT shall notify in writing any successor in interest of the requirements of this Order. RESPONDENT shall also provide a copy of this Order to any successors and assigns prior to transfer of ownership or control of the facilities.
- e. The Hearing Board shall maintain continuing jurisdiction over this matter.
