The Compliance Intern will work in the Compliance Division. The Compliance Division enforces permits, rules, and regulations; helps businesses comply; inspects businesses; reviews records; and more.

Tasks may include, but won't be limited to:

- Reviewing record submittals
- Data entry
- Inspections
- Generating compliance documents

Preferred majors for the Compliance position will be chemistry; physics; engineering; environmental, earth, or atmospheric science; geography; or a closely related technical or scientific field.

Interviews will occur in early March.

Responses to the required supplemental questionnaire will be evaluated and scored. Candidates' final score and rank on the eligibility list will be determined by their responses to the supplemental questionnaire. Applicants must receive a percentage score of at least 70 on the supplemental questionnaire ranking to be placed on the eligibility list.
