**The Planning Intern** will work in the Planning Division which includes air quality planning, emission inventory, rule development, education and outreach, grants and incentives, air monitoring, mobile source initiatives, interagency review and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review.

**Tasks may include**, but won't be limited to:

- Research and field work to support air quality planning, grants, mitigation, monitoring, and emission inventory efforts
- Report review, data entry, and outreach

*Preferred majors for the Planning position will be chemistry; physics; engineering; environmental, earth, or atmospheric science; geography; or a closely related technical or scientific field.*

1. Please explain a complex topic you've learned about recently in one paragraph.
2. Describe an idea for a new incentive program that reduces air pollution and benefits people and/or businesses in our community.
3. List two pollutants of concern for our agency (including their chemical names), and describe how reducing emissions of these pollutants ties into our agency's mission.

Work-study program is accepted but not required.

Interviews will occur in early March.

Responses to the required supplemental questionnaire will be evaluated and scored. Candidates' final score and rank on the eligibility list will be determined by their responses to the supplemental questionnaire. Applicants must receive a percentage score of at least 70 on the supplemental questionnaire ranking to be placed on the eligibility list.
