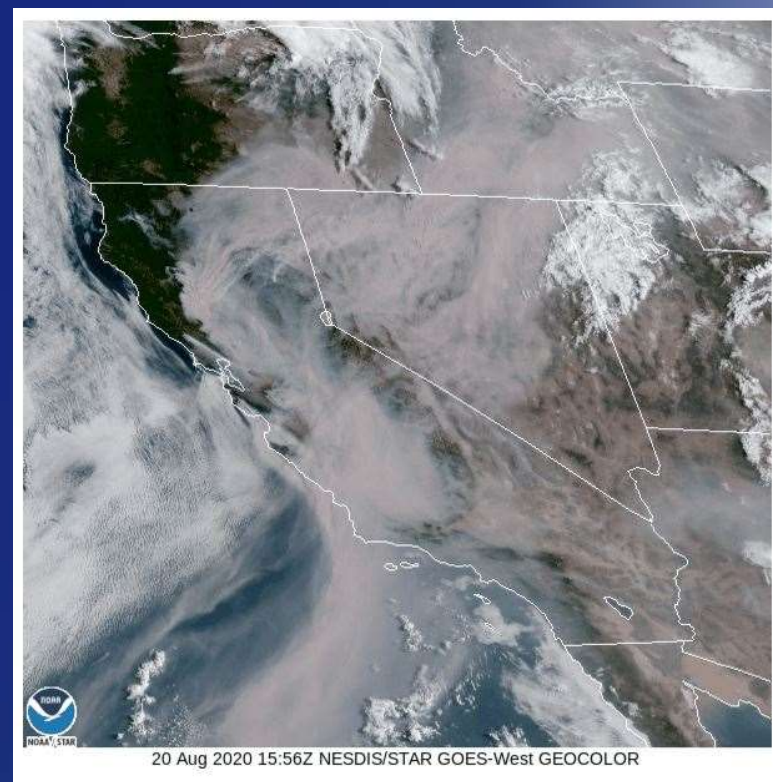

# Background

- In order to inform and protect our farming community, the Ventura County Air Pollution Control District has partnered with the County of Ventura Executive Office, County of Ventura Agricultural Commissioner's Office, and the Central Coast Alliance United for a Sustainable Economy (CAUSE) to create a first-of-its-kind Farmworker Wildfire Smoke Alert Text System



# Cal/OSHA Regulations - Title 8

## §5141.1 Protection from Wildfire Smoke

- Adopted in July 2019, the regulation applies to workplaces where:
  - Current Air Quality Index (AQI) for *PM*<sub>2.5</sub> due to wildfire smoke is 151 or greater, regardless of the AQI for other pollutants
  - The employer should reasonably anticipate that employees may be exposed to wildfire smoke
- When AQI for *PM* 2.5 reaches 151, employers are required to provide N95 masks to outdoor workers for voluntary use
- When the AQI for *PM* 2.5 exceeds 500, use of provided masks is mandatory



## Who can receive alerts?

- The text alert system is designed for agricultural frontline workers as well as field supervisors in Ventura County
  - The service is free to all subscribers; however, standard data and messaging fees may apply
- Those who wish to receive notifications can opt in by texting 'SMOKE' for English alerts or 'HUMO' for Spanish, Mixteco and Zapoteco alerts to 855-522-0034
  - Currently, the service is near 400 total subscribers
  - 215 opted to receive alerts in Spanish
  - 168 opted to receive alerts in English



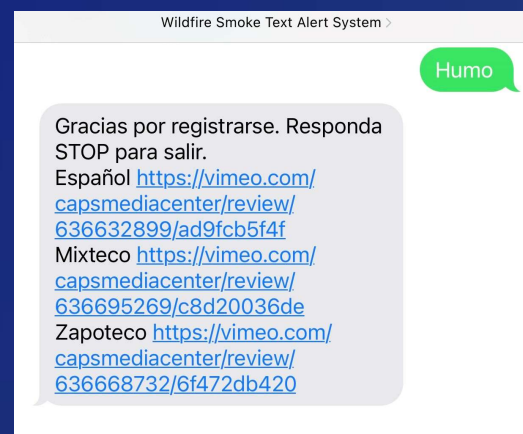

# Text Alert Sign-up and automatic response

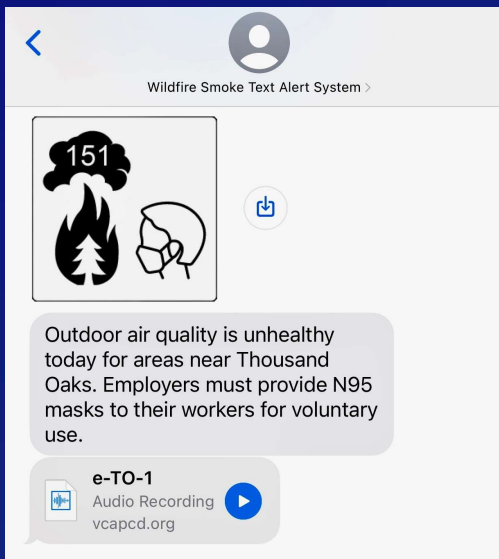
- Automatic reply to the opt-in text is a link for a tutorial video

# Text Alert Messages

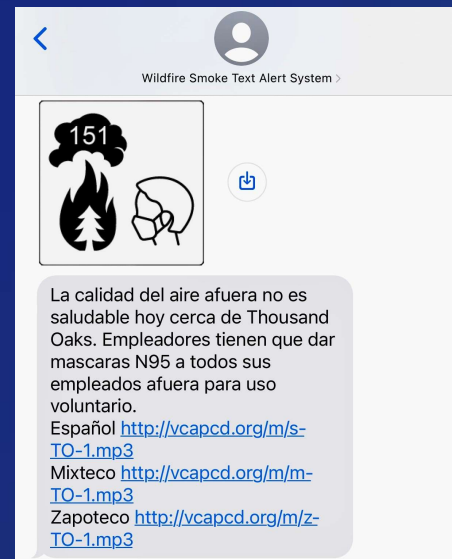
- Content of alert is sent as a MMS message containing

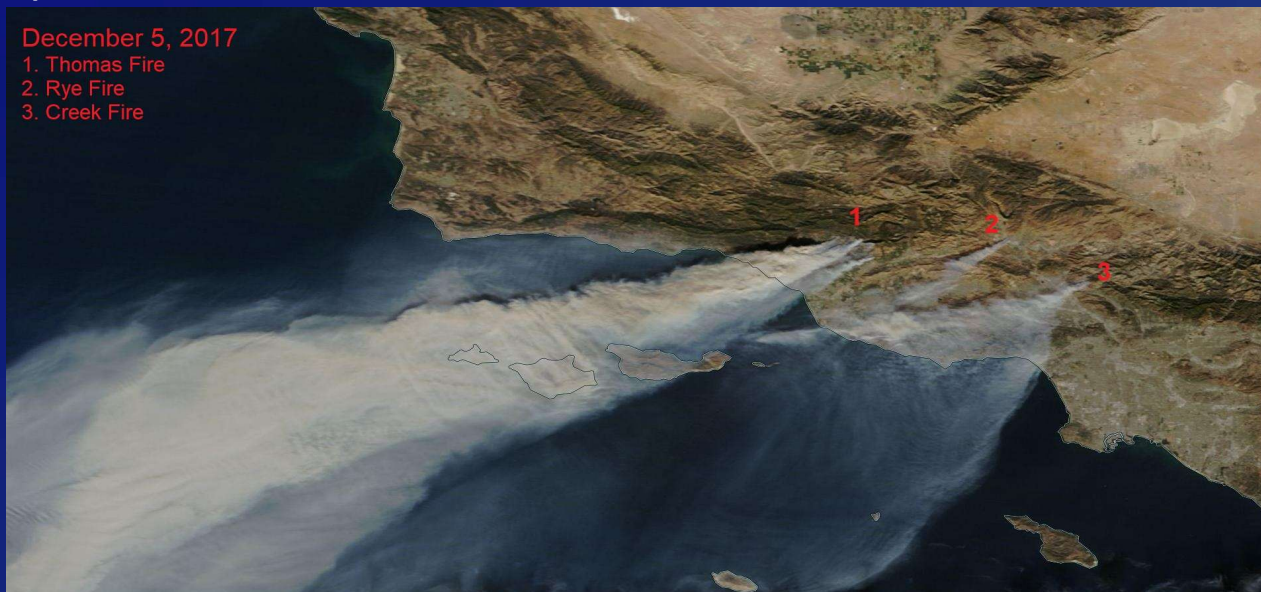

## Text Alert Messages cont.

- Alerts will be sent once per day to all zones where air quality deterioration due to wildfire smoke causes AQI values for PM 2.5 to exceed Cal OSHA specified levels
  - Messages will be sent daily until AQI values for PM 2.5 fall below alert criteria
- Multiple messages per day will be sent if conditions worsen or alert zones need to be expanded.



# How to Check Air Quality

- Use the EPA website [www.airnow.gov](http://www.airnow.gov) or their respective app if available on your phone
- It can be a good idea to wear a N95 mask at lower AQI levels to reduce exposure, especially for those with medical conditions such as asthma or heart problems, etc.
