


Federal & State Happenings

 - No proposed changes to 24-hour PM2.5 standard or PM 10 standards

- Non-Attainment Transitional for Ozone
 - ► CARB Public Hearing on January 26
 - ► Goal is to achieve **and** maintain
- State budget
 - ▶ Reductions in grants & incentives
