




## **Background: Ship Emissions**

- Santa Barbara Channel Region is a heavilytrafficked shipping corridor.
  - Vessels are outside District's regulatory control.
  - ▶ District staff has been advocating for federal & international emission controls since 1994.
- ➤ 2022 Ozone Plan: Forecasted Growth in emissions from Marine Shipping until 2035.
  - ▶ New Ships: Federal & International regulations require emission controls (e.g. Tier 3 engines).
  - **Existing Ships:** Can continue operating older engines until retired (10-15+ years).






## Santa Barbara County OGV Emissions

67.33 tons/day







#### Blue Whales And Blue Skies Program

- Air Districts, National Marine Sanctuaries, Non-Profits, and Foundations
- Asks shipping companies to voluntarily slow down to 10 knots or less
- Benefits:
  - Significant emission reductions (NOx, GHGs, Particulate Matter, Air Toxics)
  - ► Reduce risk of fatal ship strikes on whales
  - Reduce ocean noise
- Began as 2014 pilot in Santa Barbara Channel & expanded each year (2016-2022)





#### 2022 Program - VSR Zones







#### 2022 Program - Criteria

- Seasonal program: May 1 December 15, 2022
  - Coincides with high ozone levels and presence of whales.
- Open to containerships, auto carrier, bulk, and general cargo companies.
- Recognition based on <u>% of total fleet distance</u> traveled at 10 knots or less.

#### **Recognition Awards**

Sapphire	85 - 100%
Gold	60 - 84%
Blue Sky	35 - 59%



#### 2022 Results (Available Soon)

- Over \$200,000 in total incentive funds available.
  - Many financial awards are being declined by the companies. (\$2,500 to \$20,000 for Gold and Sapphire awards)
  - Cooperation and Benefit calculations will be available in the upcoming news release.






### 2023 Program - Begins

#### Expanded Regions:


- Add the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary.

#### **Future Statewide Control Efforts**

# CARB - Interim Evaluation on the 2020 Control Measure for OGVs At Berth

- ▶ Regulation requires shoreside power for OGVs when docked at berth (Years 2023 2027).
- The report also evaluated control techniques for OGVs at anchor.
- CARB staff recommend additional incentive or regulatory measures to reduce emissions from OGVs transiting, maneuvering, and anchoring.
- ► CARB Board to discuss at May 25, 2023 meeting.

#### **Assembly Bill 953**

- Introduced in February 2023
- Sponsored by Assembly Members Connolly and Hart
- Would expand the VSR program statewide
- Would provide additional support for continuing the emission reduction efforts.

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - The Santa Barbara County Air Pollution District (APCD) is sponsoring <u>AB 953</u> (Assemblymembers Gregg Hart and Damon Connolly) to build upon and expand the voluntary vessel speed reduction program, <u>Protecting Blue Whales and Blue Skies</u>, statewide. Expansion of the speed reduction and sustainable shipping program for the entire California coast would reduce air pollution, greenhouse gases, and the risk of fatal vessel strikes on whales.
