SUBJECT: Expiring Terms on APCD Hearing Board

The Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) Hearing Board is a quasi-judicial body made up of five members appointed by, but acting independently of, the APCD Board of Directors. The Hearing Board was established to hear appeals of Air Pollution Control Officer (APCO) permit decisions, applications for variances from District Rules and Regulations, and petitions for abatement orders submitted by the APCO. The members of the Hearing Board have professional experience in the fields of medicine, engineering, law and include two members of the public.

Mr. Terence Dressler has been serving as a public member representative on the Hearing Board since June 2017. His current term is set to expire August 2023. Should the Board wish to extend his term, Mr. Dressler has expressed interest in continuing his position on the Hearing Board.

Mr. Frank Peters has been serving in the engineering position as a public member on the Hearing Board since June 2017. His current term is set to expire August 2023. Mr. Peters has indicated that he will fulfil his term but will not seek reappointment after that.

As referenced in the enclosed Hearing Board Nominating Committee Agenda, immediately following the regular APCD Board Meeting on May 18, 2023, your Committee will meet to discuss either to recommend the reappointment of Mr. Terence Dressler to the APCD Hearing Board or begin the search for a new member, and receive an update on recruitment efforts for the upcoming vacant position. The pending Hearing Board vacancy is for the engineer position; however, based on the size of Santa Barbara County, if the District is unable to appoint an engineer, a member of the public may serve this position.
