



# Fiscal Year 2024-25 Summary of Grant & Incentive Funds



> Community Air Protection (Yr 7): \$1,066,970

> Carl Moyer (Yr 26): \$949,857

> \$2 DMV Surcharge Revenue: \$798,367

➤ Woodsmoke Reduction: \$445,004

➤ Clean Air Fund for Lompoc: \$325,000

> Carl Moyer State Reserve (Yr 26): \$232,688

TOTAL: \$3,817,886





## Landscape Equipment Electrification Fund

- ➤ LEEF (Year 4)
  ➤ \$780,356 liquidated in FY 2024-25
  ➤ 65 projects
  ➤ 810 pieces of equipment
- Funded with Carl Moyer State Reserve Year 24 & \$2 DMV
- ➤ Replacement of gasoline/diesel landscaping equipment with electric equipment for businesses, schools, public agencies, and non-profit organizations.

#### **Old Car Buy Back Program**

- >FY 2025-26 Program Expansion
  - **►** Add a Santa Maria Dismantler (SA Recycling)
  - **≻**Change in model year from 1997 or older to 2002 or older
  - ➤ Increased end user incentive from \$1,000 to \$2,200 per vehicle
  - **▶**Increased dismantler incentive from \$250 to \$300 per vehicle

#### **Heat Clean Program**

- ➤ Voucher funds to replace wood-burning stoves or fireplaces with efficient heat pumps or electric fireplace inserts.
- ➤ Incentives range from \$2,500 to \$12,000 depending on project type and location.





#### **Clean Air Rooms Program**

**→** Guadalupe and Old Town Goleta

➤ In FY 2025-26, provide high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) purifiers to residents in the City of Guadalupe and Old Town Goleta.



#### **Clean Air Fund Program**


➤ Air filtration system projects for the City of Lompoc, Lompoc Boys & Girls Club, and Lompoc Family YMCA.

**➢ Ultra-Low Emitting Formaldehyde composite wood furniture replacement for Lompoc Unified School District.** 





# Fiscal Year 2025-26 Proposed Summary of Grant & Incentive Funds
