SUBJECT: Report of Air Pollution Control Officer Signed Contracts in 2025

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive and file a report of certain specified legal contracts, not exceeding \$3,500 each, entered into or amended by the Air Pollution Control Officer during the calendar year 2025.

DISCUSSION:

On January 17, 2019, your Board adopted a resolution granting authority to the Air Pollution Control Officer (APCO) to amend, enter into, and renew legal contracts for equipment, materials, supplies, and services (but not construction) including, but not limited to, the following list of activities:

- Meeting room rental and logistics;
- District staff training;
- Recruitment testing materials;
- Temporary employment agencies; and
- Equipment maintenance.

The total dollar amount of all specified legal contracts entered into by the APCO is within the budget authorized by your Board during the budget adoption process. On an annual basis, the APCO shall provide a report to your Board on the contracts entered into under this delegated authority.

In 2025, the Air Pollution Control Officer did not entered into, amended, or renew any legal contracts to report. Although no contracts were executed in 2025, this report is provided in accordance with your Board's resolution to ensure continued transparency and accountability.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact for this action. The District's contribution towards these expenses were included in the FY 2024-25 and FY 2025-26 budgets that were adopted by your Board on June 20, 2024 and June 26, 2025 respectively.
