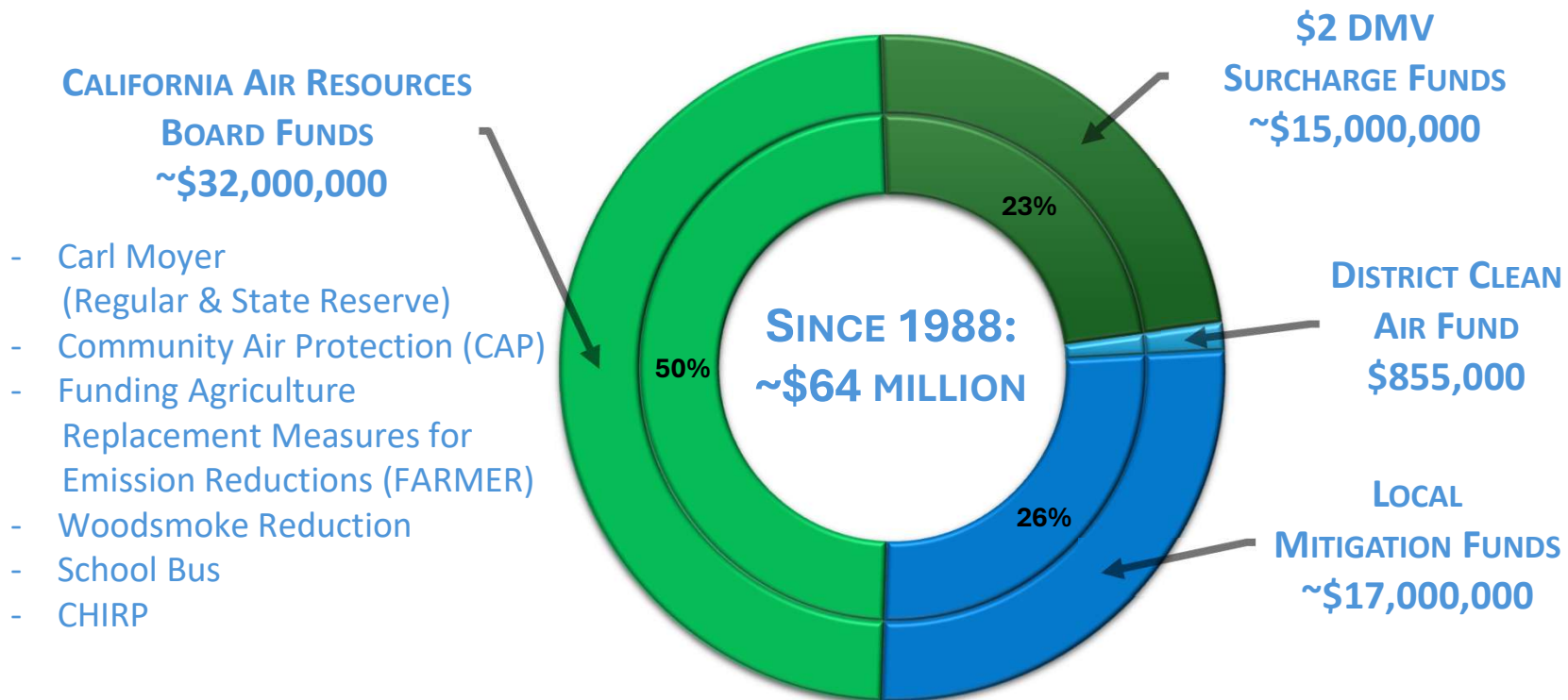

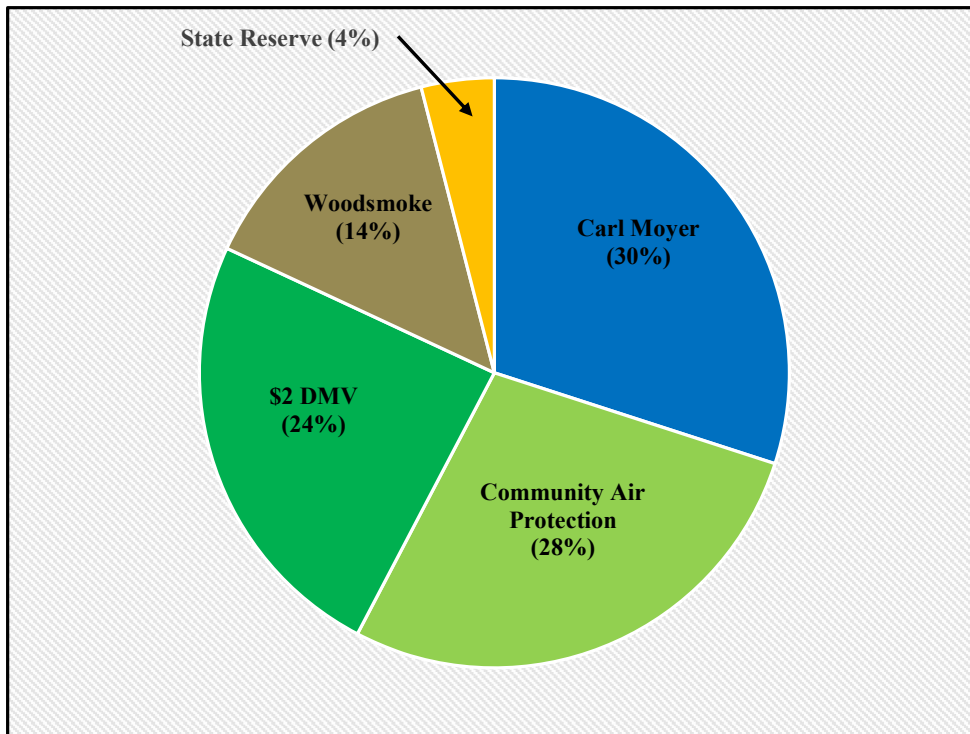


Clean Air Grant & Incentive Fund History

Summary of Grant & Incentive Funds



- Carl Moyer (Yr 27): \$948,138
 - Community Air Protection (Yr 8): \$874,988
 - \$2 DMV Surcharge Revenue: \$765,857
 - Woodsmoke Reduction: \$445,004
 - Carl Moyer State Reserve (Yr 27): \$126,552
- TOTAL: \$3,160,539

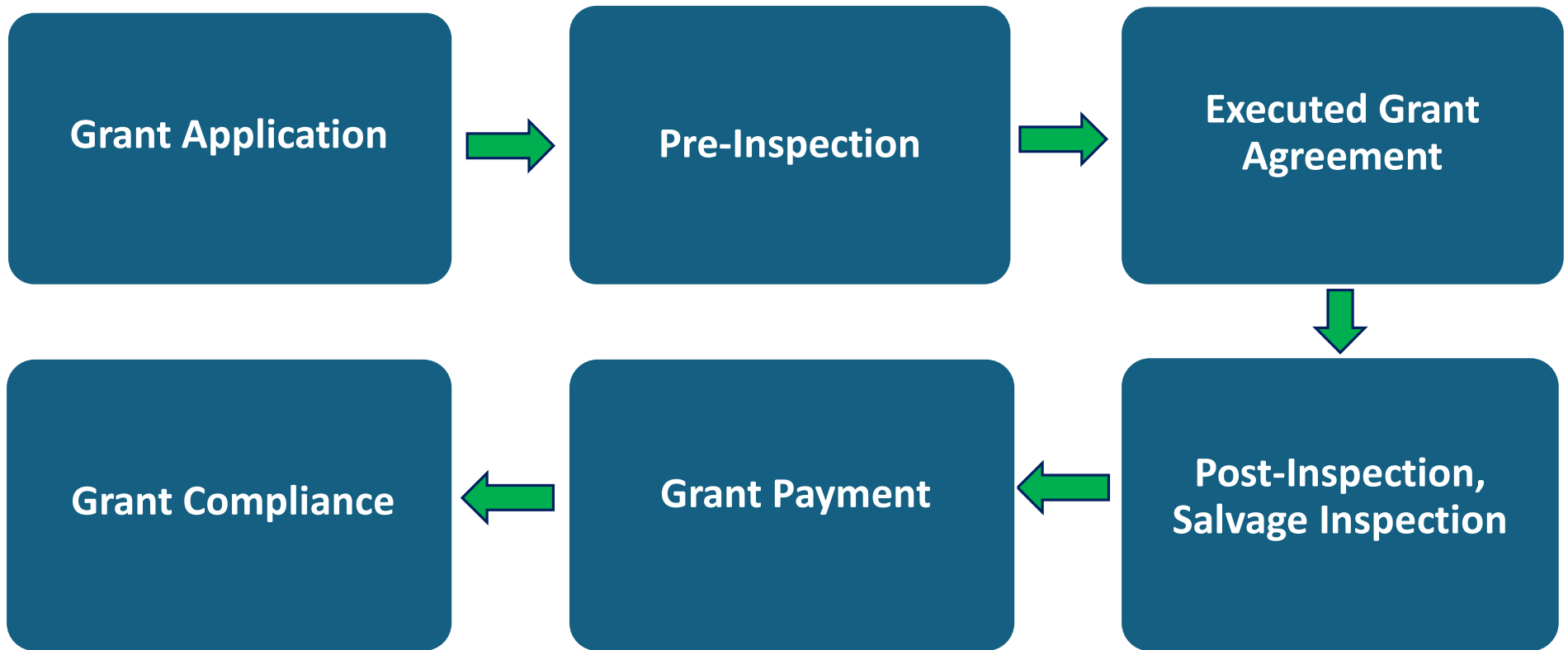

Old Car Buy Back Program

➤ FY 2025-26 Program

- Five total dismantlers
- New model year from 1997 to 2002 or older
- End user increase from \$1,000 to \$2,200
- Dismantler increase from \$250 to \$300 per vehicle

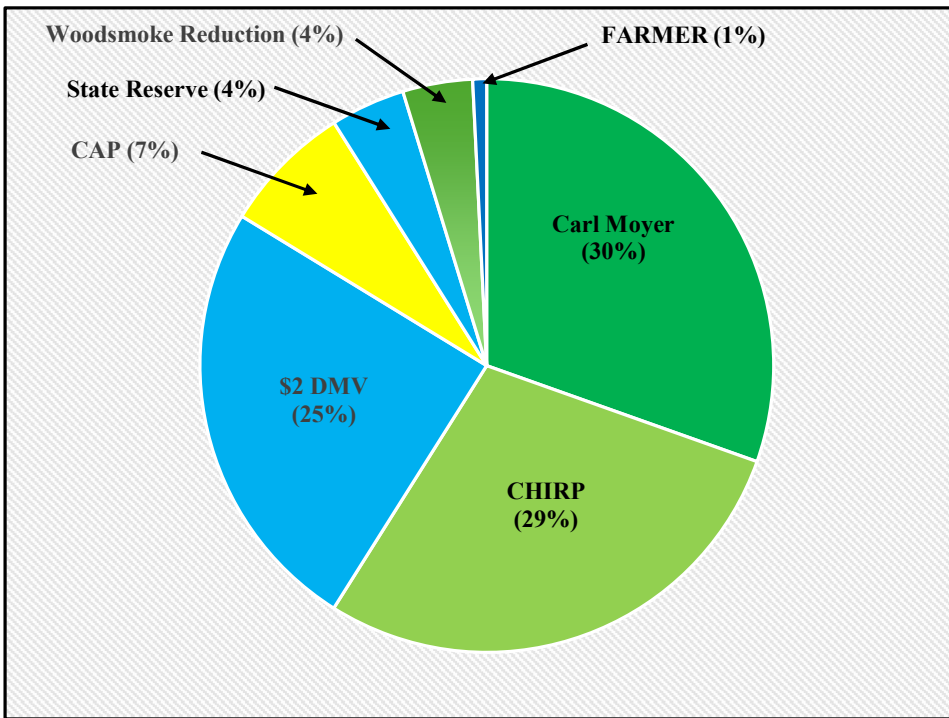


Heat Clean Program

- Voucher funds to replace wood-burning stoves or fireplaces with efficient heat pumps or electric fireplace inserts
- Incentives range from \$2,500 to \$12,000 depending on project type and applicant eligibility



Fiscal Year 2026-27 Proposed Summary of Grant & Incentive Funds



- Carl Moyer (Yr 28): \$950,177
- CHIRP: \$890,834
- \$2 DMV Surcharge Revenue: \$773,178
- Community Air Protection (Yr 9): \$228,934
- Carl Moyer State Reserve (Yr 28): \$131,442
- Woodsmoke Reduction: \$123,448
- FARMER (Yr 9): \$24,400

TOTAL: \$3,122,413



2026 Clean Air Grant Program

40-day application window
July 27 - September 04

- A successful project will be eligible to receive a grant within a range from \$10,000 to \$250,000.
- Actual grant amounts vary based on several factors, including but not limited to location, usage, cost-effectiveness, emission reductions, eligible project costs, and fund availability.



Climate Heat Impact Response Program (CHIRP)

- \$490,834 in funding for diesel emergency backup generator replacements from CARB's Climate Heat Impact Response Program (CHIRP).
- Co-Funded with \$400,000 from the Districts Clean Air Fund.
- Diesel Particulate Filters eligible for funding.
