No. 1

Title: Increase Restricted \$4 DMV Fund Balance

Budget Action: Establish appropriations of \$9,095 to increase Restricted \$4 DMV fund balance by unanticipated unspent proceeds at year end.

No. 2

Title: Increase Committed Operational Activities Fund Balance

Budget Action: At the end of the fiscal year the District deposits or withdrawal residual/net profit (loss) from it's Operational Activities Fund Balance. The ending amount for FY 2025-26 was \$472,402

No. 3

Title: Increase Committed Data Acquisition System (DAS) Fund Balance

Budget Action: Establish appropriations of \$38,314 to increase the DAS fund balance by unanticipated unspent proceeds at year end.

No. 4

Title: Increase Committed Monitoring Program Fund Balance

Budget Action: Establish appropriations of \$119,217 to increase the Monitoring fund balance by unanticipated unspent proceeds at year end.

No. 5

Title: Increase Committed Clean Air Fund Program Fund Balance

Budget Action: Establish appropriations of \$409,208 to increase the SEP fund balance by excess notice of violation proceeds at year end.
