

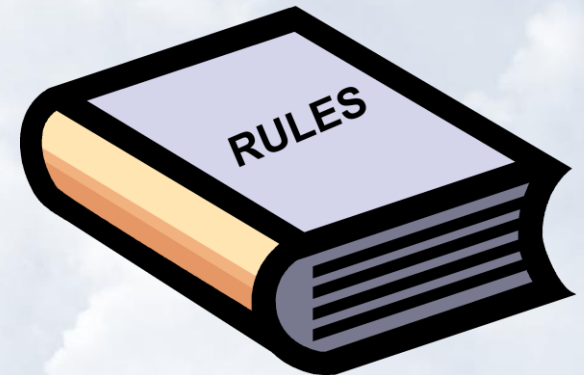

Project

Objectives

- Purposes of the briefing
 - Provide a general overview of the project,
 - Obtain CAC input on it, and
 - Obtain a CAC recommendation that our Board of Directors should adopt Rule 323.1

Background

- Existing Architectural Coatings Rule 323
 - Based on the 2000 ARB Suggested Control Measure (SCM)
 - Reduced Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) by ~ 40 TPY by lowering coating VOC content limits

Reason for Amending the Architectural Coating Rule Requirements

- ARB updated their 2000 SCM in 2007.
- By adopting the ARB 2007 SCM, we will be able to further reduce VOC emissions

Adoption of Rule 323.1 will fulfill a commitment made in the 2010 Clean Air Plan

Key Provisions of the Rule

- New Coating Categories
- Table of VOC Content Limits
- Sell-Through Provisions
- Painting Practices
- Phasing out of Rule 323

Implications

- Coating Manufacturers
- Painters
- Cost Effectiveness
- VOC Emission Reduction

Public Review

- Proposed Rule and the Project Description Summary released to the public in February
- Held a Public Workshop and Stakeholder meeting in March
- Early April sent notice to stakeholders on project revisions
