## Be a Clean Air Ambassador!

The [Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District](#) seeks college students to participate in our Clean Air Ambassadors program in northern Santa Barbara County (Santa Maria, Lompoc, and Guadalupe area). This is a **paid, part-time** position with a \$15-\$17/hour pay range. New Ambassadors will gain teaching experience by helping elementary-level students learn about air pollution and ways to help improve air quality.

### Projects:

- Assist air district staff with the ongoing development of elementary-level curriculum that includes engaging activities related to impact of air pollution;
- Solicit teacher participation in northern Santa Barbara County;
- Co-teach the hands-on, interactive curriculum in elementary school classrooms;
- Possibly work at the air district outreach booth at community events throughout northern Santa Barbara County, such as Earth Day or school science/STEM events.

### Requirements:

- Interested and enthusiastic to teach environmental education
- Able to learn basic air quality concepts
- Previous work experience with children ages 5-8 (including coaching, camp counseling and/or other related experience)
- Occasional morning availability for school visits
- Must have access to a vehicle and the ability to travel throughout Santa Barbara County (travel costs are reimbursed to the student)
- Ability to work as part of a team as well as individually

Preferably the new Ambassadors will work with the Clean Air Ambassadors program at least until June 2023. Flexible schedule up to 15 hours per week, with a rare/occasional evening or weekend commitment for community events. The air district will work to accommodate class schedules. Upon passing a background check, the new Ambassadors will work remotely, in our Santa Maria office, as well as travel to schools throughout northern Santa Barbara County.
