Topic: <u>Using the Request for Information Form</u>	
Distribution: <u>All Policy Holders</u>	

Section 42303 of the California Health and Safety Code authorizes the APCD to request from a permit holder any information required to substantiate compliance with permit conditions or applicable rules and regulations. Failure to respond to such a request made by the APCD is a violation of Section 42303, and the penalty for this violation may include suspension of the permit.

A 42303 letter should be used whenever an inspector or project manager needs information from a permit holder which 1) the APCD has previously requested but the permit holder has failed to provide, 2) is required by a condition of the permit but has not been submitted, or 3) is found to be necessary to determine the compliance status of the permit holder.

The Request for Information Form (attached) has been printed to produce carbonless copies, for ease of issuance in the field. The letter describes the potential for permit suspension as a consequence of failure to comply with the request, and this should be explained to the permit holder at the time of issuance. The staff member issuing the letter should carefully consider the amount of time required for the permit holder to comply with the request. Except in unusual circumstances, no less than 10 and no more than 20 days shall be allowed for response.

The staff member issuing a 42303 letter shall submit the copy to the division clerk, who will maintain a suspense file and will return the copy to the staff member on the date the requested information is due. This will provide access to the letters for supervisors and the division manager, in the event that phone requests from permit holders asking for clarification are received.

If the requested information has been received by the due date, the staff member will attach the copy of the 42303 letter to the submittal and the material will be filed. If the requested information has not been received, the staff member will make a recommendation for further action to his/her supervisor. Options for further action include issuance of a Notice of Violation for failure to comply with Section 42303, and initiation of permit suspension by sending the Notice of Intent to Suspend Permit to the permit holder.
