

OLD CAR BUY BACK PROGRAM UPDATE

The District's Old Car Buy Back Program currently pays Santa Barbara County vehicle owners \$1,000 to voluntarily retire their fully legal and operational 1993 or older light or medium duty car, truck, or SUV. The program accelerates the improvement of air quality by removing high polluting vehicles from the fleet quicker than normal attrition. Funding for the program is derived from DMV registration surcharge revenue.

Program Milestones:

- 5/1/2006: Program Launched
- 10/10/2008: Eligible model year increased from 1988 to 1992
- 5/20/2010: Payment amount increased from \$800 to \$1,000/vehicle
- 2/3/2011 to 11/7/2011: Program suspended
- 10/8/2011: Program restarted; Eligible model year increased from 1992 to 1993
