- Liquid leaks must be repaired within 24 hours.
- Vapor leaks must be repaired within 24 hours unless parts must be ordered.
- Parts must be ordered within two working days of the detection of a vapor leak.
- Ordered parts must be installed within five working days after receipt.
- A vapor leak that cannot be repaired fifteen working days after detection, the owner/operator shall not operate the drycleaning equipment without a leak extension from the APCD.
