Hearing – To consider an application by ExxonMobil Production Company submitted on May 05, 2017. As a result of the Plains All American Pipeline (AAPL) Line 901 failure on May 19, 2015, ExxonMobil Production Company has shut down operations and facility equipment has been preserved to manage its integrity. At this time, it is unclear when the restart of the Petitioners facility may occur.

The Petitioner is currently operating under Regular Variance Order 2016-13-R, which provides relief from the below conditions through June 05, 2017 (or the date the facility resumes platform gas processing, whichever occurs first). Per Health and Safety Code §42357, the Petitioner is requesting a Modification of Final Compliance Date for Variance 2016-13-R to extend coverage through June 5, 2019, or the date the facility resumes platform gas processing, whichever occurs first. If granted, the variance would provide continued relief from the requirements associated with operating an H2S analyzer to continuously measure H2S concentrations in the gas, as specified in District Rules 328 and 206, Conditions 9.C.7(a)(i), 9.C.12, and 9.C.12(a) of Permit to Operate 8092. The Petitioner operates the equipment described in this Petition at the POPCO gas processing plant, approximately 25 miles northwest of Santa Barbara, CA.


Hearing – To consider an application by ExxonMobil Production Company submitted on May 05, 2017. As a result of the Plains All American Pipeline (AAPL) Line 901 failure on May 19, 2015, ExxonMobil Production Company has shut down operations and facility equipment has been preserved to manage its integrity. At this time, it is unclear when the restart of the Petitioner's facility may occur.

The Petitioner is currently operating under Regular Variance Order 2016-15-R, which provides relief from the below conditions through June 25, 2017 (or within 90 days of POPCO resuming the processing of platform gas, whichever occurs first), and Regular Variance Order and 2016-33-R, which provides relief from the below conditions through December 31, 2017 (or within 90 days after the date the facility resumes processing platform gas, whichever occurs first). Per Health and Safety Code §42357, the Petitioner is requesting a Modification of Final Compliance Date for Regular Variances 2016-15-R and 2016-33-R to extend variance coverage through June 25, 2019, or within 90 calendar days of

POPCO resuming the processing of platform gas, whichever occurs first. Per Health and Safety Code §42356, the Petitioner is also requesting Regular Variance 2016-15-R and 2016-33-R be incorporated into a single variance, effectively terminating 2016-15-R and 2016-33-R. If granted, the variance would provide continued relief from the requirements to perform source testing on multiple pieces of permitted equipment, as specified in District Rules 328, 342, and 206, Conditions 9.C.1(c)(iii), 9.C.5(b)(v), 9.C.7(c)(ii), 9.C.12, 9.C.12(b), and 9.C.18(a) of Part 70/Permit to Operate 8092. The Petitioner operates the equipment described in this Petition at the POPCO gas processing plant, approximately 25 miles northwest of Santa Barbara, CA.
