Notice is hereby given that the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board will hold a public hearing to consider the following matters on Wednesday, October 04, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. at the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, 105 East Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara, California, 93110. Said Petition is on file with the Clerk of the APCD Hearing Board and is available for public inspection during regular business hours. Hearing – To consider an application by Venoco, LLC. submitted on September 12, 2017 for a Modification of the Final Compliance Date of Regular Variance No. 2016-27-R. The Petitioner is requesting continued relief from District Rule 206, Conditions 9.C.17, 9.C.18, and 9.C.19 of Part 70/Permit to Operate 7904. This requires that the Petitioner operate an odor monitoring station (for hydrogen sulfide). An odor monitoring station was operated until October 2015 when the lease for the property where the station was located terminated due to the property owner's recently approved development plans. The Petitioner has yet to secure a new location for the monitoring station. In addition, the facility's operations were impacted by the Plains All American Pipeline Line 901 failure on May 19, 2015. The Petitioner operates the equipment described in the Petition at the Ellwood Onshore Facility (EOF) located approximately 14 miles west of the City of Santa Barbara, California.

On October 05, 2016, the Hearing Board heard and issued Regular Variance Order 2016-27-R, providing relief from the above conditions through October 21, 2017, or the date compliance is achieved, or the date the facility resumes oil and gas processing, whichever occurs first. Per Health and Safety Code §42357, the Petitioner is requesting a Modification of Final Compliance Date, extending variance coverage through October 21, 2018, or the date compliance is achieved, whichever occurs first. Per Health and Safety Code §42356, the District is recommending a Modification of Variance, should the owner or operator change over the course of the variance period. There are no expected emissions related to the granting of the Petitioners request.
